Accomplishments & Activities during Report Year:

ISCPM Seminars: The Society sponsored two seminars in 2010. The spring seminar “Outing the Elephant: Understanding and Addressing Bullying Behavior in the Workplace” was offered on May 12, 2010. This session had 43 attendees. The fall seminar was “Increasing Your Resilience.” It was offered on November 4, 2010 and had 61 attendees. Both of these training seminars were free to members of the Idaho Society of Certified Public Managers. The charge for these sessions was \$30.00 for individuals that are not members of the Society. In the past, seminars were an excellent way of raising money for the Society. For the last two years, the board has offered seminars at a rate that only covered our expenses. The board decision was based on current economic conditions and the inability of state employees and state agencies to pay for training. The desire was to fulfill our mission to offer learning opportunities in the best way possible.

Goals and Objectives/Progress to date:

The ISCPM web site and e-mails are the primary method of communication with our members. The current board recommends the web site be changed to make it easier for board members to update. The current site is difficult for non-technical staff to update.

Issues of Concern (State and/or National Level):

Challenges: The ISCPM is in a strong position to continue moving in a positive direction. New board members with fresh ideas will be a tremendous asset to the ISCPM. The challenges I am mentioning are issues I hope the board takes into consideration during the next calendar year. Issues for consideration are:
