Accomplishments & Activities during Report Year:

Eleventh Professional Seminar - May 25, 2010 – "Successful Leadership with Limited Resources" was held at the Kentucky History Center in Frankfort. Speakers: Crit Luallen, State Auditor of Public Accounts; Jeff Jasper, Director at Kentucky Transportation Cabinet; Katy Cave, KSCPM Member and Governmental Services Center Instructor; and Rodger Bingham (Kentucky Joe), Deputy Executive Director of Office of Agricultural Marketing and Product Promotion for the state of Kentucky and also appeared on the TV show, **Survivor: The Australian Outback**;

The KSCPM Professional Seminar was a financial success, helped by the Governor's Office sending out a statewide email to all state employees. Additionally, the Governors office declared May 25, 2010 as Certified Public Managers® Day within the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The Summer Luncheon Meeting was held on July 22nd at the Department of Criminal Justice Training Complex on the campus of Eastern Kentucky University in Richmond, Kentucky. Amanda Basham and Elyse Christian, Law Enforcement Instructors from the Department of Criminal Justice Training were the guest speakers.

Ande Godsey, Robinil Jameson, Jennifer Woods, Larry Totten, Cassidy Connell, and Lyn Keelling represented the KSCPM at the Kentucky Certified Public Manager Graduation Ceremony held on November 4th. Ten KSCPM members were graduates. Since 1986, 1,075 people have received the Certified Public Manager® designation in Kentucky.

The Fall Luncheon Meeting was held on September 30th at the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority Building in Frankfort. Jill Anderson from Personnel Cabinet was our guest speaker.

In October, three members of KSCPM attended the 22nd Annual AACPM Professional Development Conference in Oklahoma.

The traditional Annual Membership & Election Meeting was held on December 7th at the Berry Hill Mansion in Frankfort.

The 2010 AACPM Askew Award was presented to the team responsible for the project titled "Oversight of Online/Distance Education Providers in the Commonwealth of Kentucky" at the KSCPM Annual Awards meeting. Team members include Gregory Giesler, Donna Melton, Davie Ransdell, Brandon Sanders, Teresa Sanders, and Tonya Stallard.

KSCPM published four editions of "The Cutting Edge" newsletter during the months of March, June, September, and December.

Goals and Objectives/Progress to Date:

- Plan and execute a Spring State Seminar.
- Continue to expand the Society membership by offering quality opportunities for members to network, learn new management techniques, and refresh current skills.
- Spring Seminar was completed successfully on May 25th.
- Membership expanded from 52 members in 2009 to 61 members in 2010.

Issues of Concern (State and/or National Level):

The primary concern at the state and national level involves the lack of commitment to the program by the current Kentucky Consortium members. There is not evidence of any interest in continuing the Certified Public Manager program from the Governmental Services Center and the Personnel Cabinet. Based on discussion with various consortium members in Oklahoma there is no policies or guidelines that allow a consortium member to be removed from having control of the state's program. This inability to remove consortium members that no longer have an active program greatly restricts the ability of state societies to flourish. The state level society should be allowed to request intervention by the consortium if the state society feels that the program owners are no longer interested in maintaining the certification. This would allow the state societies the ability to work with interested parties.
